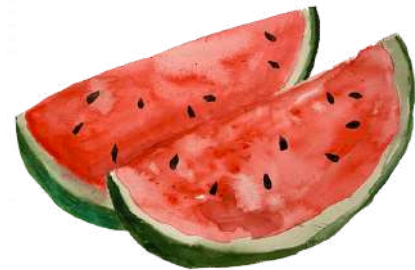


August Newsletter
